We are thrilled to share that we have received approval from the Dutch 'central committee on research involving human subject' for our study!

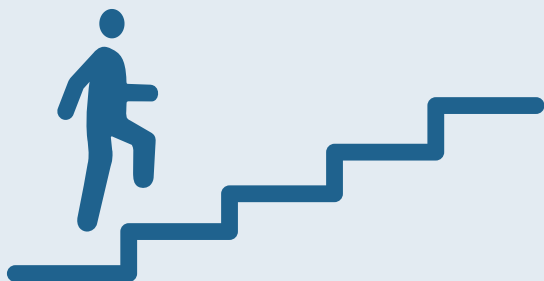


It has been a frustrating long wait, but it's there now. Thank you for your continued support on this important journey, we couldn't be more excited about the opportunities that lie ahead.

FOLLOW UP STUDY

We are busy working on the follow-up study. Here we not only look at the medical outcomes for mother and child, but we also aim to assess how anxiety, depression, and other mental health factors influence the quality of life for those affected by fetal growth restriction. Pregnancy is a life-defining period, events such as early-onset fetal growth restriction can have a profound impact on mental health. Understanding the psychological consequences is crucial for improving overall care and outcomes. With the help of Ellen Løkkegaard, we are working closely with patient representatives, psychologists, and psychiatrists who specialize in maternal and paternal mental health to ensure that these important aspects are thoroughly addressed.

The FGR PODS cohort, is a parallel study, completely aligned with the SAVE FGR study. Interested centers across Europe will collect the same observational data. Thus we create a rich dataset in which we can validate the decision support tool for the optimal timing of delivery in early-onset FGR.
