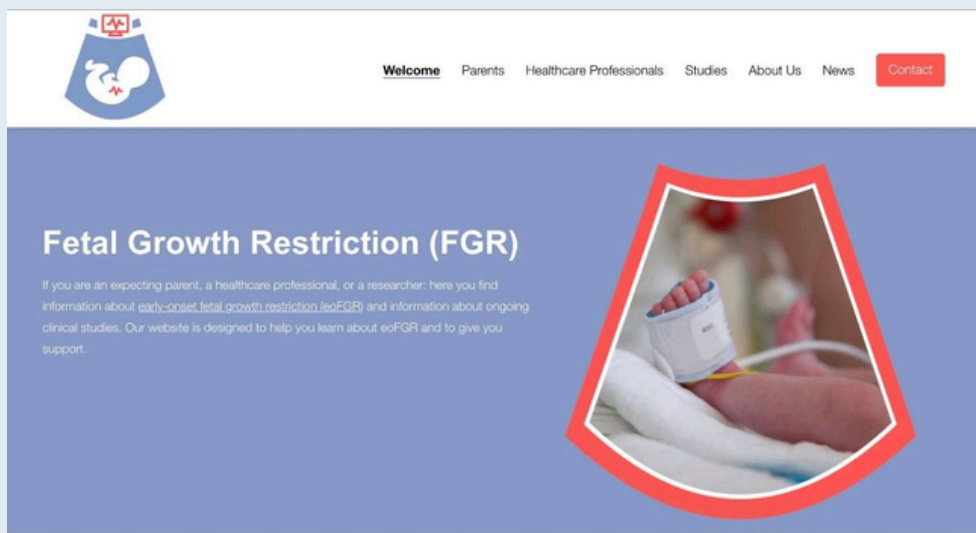


## WEBSITE IS LIVE !!

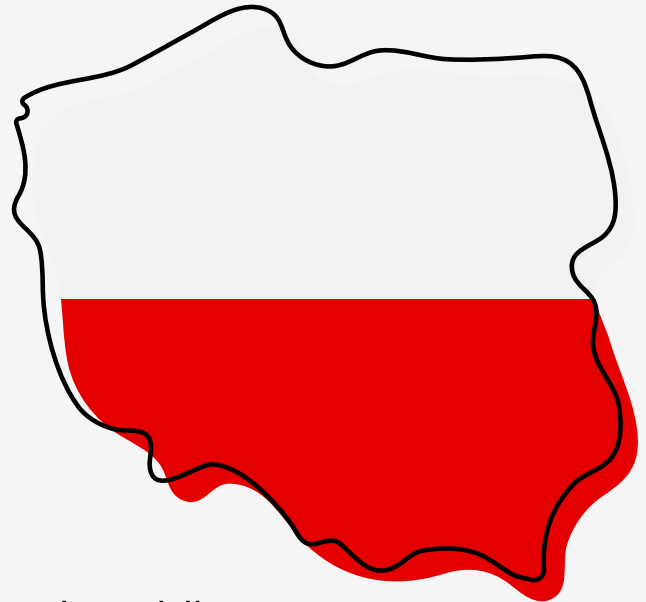
